OSHA has proposed a new rule that has been published in the Federal Register and is now available for viewing. OSHA is encouraging the submission of public comments in response to the proposed rule. The comment period ends on June 21, 2024.

The focus of the proposed Emergency Response rule is to provide basic workplace protections for workers who respond to emergencies as part of their regularly assigned duties. It expands the scope to include emergency medical services and technical search and rescue, so your comments are important as this rule moves forward.
